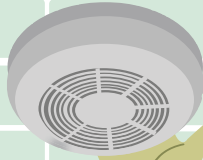
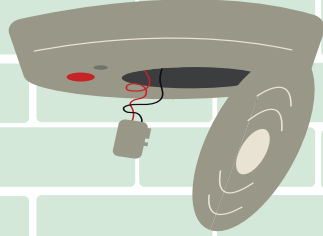

Do you test your smoke alarm?

Did you know that you are
twice as likely to die in a fire
if you don't have working
smoke alarms?



Smoke Alarm Tips

Take care of your smoke alarms:

- Test smoke alarms regularly.
- Replace batteries if your smoke alarm beeps intermittently.
- OR, if you have a 10-year alarm, replace the **WHOLE** alarm every 10 years.

Location, location, location:

- Fit a working smoke alarm on every level of your home.
- Place smoke alarms in the middle of rooms or hallways, at least 30cm from walls and light fittings.
- Avoid smoke alarms in kitchens and bathrooms and instead fit heat alarms.

Is your alarm ok?

- Check your alarms have the **British Kitemark BSEN14604 : 2005** on them.
- Never ignore a bleeping smoke alarm, this could save your life.
